Voluntary Code of Good Practice

- 1) **Respecting the rules and guidelines of the relevant navigation authority.**
- 2) **Keeping boats in a condition which complements the local environment.**
- 3) **Mooring considerately and in line with any local signage.**
- 4) **Respecting land-based users by not causing an obstruction or detracting from their enjoyment of the waterways.**
- 5) **Keeping boats in a safe condition, so they do not present a hazard to users of our waterways.**
- 6) **Respecting neighbours, whether on land or water.**
- 7) **Whilst boating, being considerate to other boats, whether on the move or moored.**
- 8) **Respecting the built and natural environments and the heritage of the waterways.**
- 9) **Being willing to share knowledge/skills with others.**
- 10) **Working with the Residential Boat Owners' Association to support responsible use of the waterways.**
